The United Nations Sustainable Development Goals...

...(SDG's) or Global Goals, set in 2015 are a collection of 17 interlinked global goals designed to be a „blueprint to achieve a better and more sustainable future for all“ to be achieved by the year 2030.

With only nine years left in this decade of change, GR42 enters the global market providing a sustainable solution to combat desertification, halt and reverse land degradation whilst halting bio diversity loss.

GR42 is focused on...



....achieving the following UN Sustainable Development Targets by 2030:

15.3 By 2030 combat desertification, restore degraded land and soil, including land affected by desertification, droughts and floods, and strive to achieve a land degradation-neutral world

17.17 Encourage and promote effective public, public-private and civil society partnerships, building on experience and resourcing strategies of partnerships

Through achieving these UNs targets GR42 is a catalyst for change and will help support those focused on achieving the following global UN goals and targets:

2. Zero hunger

2.4 By 2030, ensure sustainable food production systems and implement agricultural practices that increase productivity and production, that help maintain ecosystems, that strengthen capacity for adaptation to climate change, extreme weather, drought, flooding and other disasters and that progressively improve land and soil quality





3. Good health & well-being

- 3.9** By 2030, substantially reduce the number of deaths and illnesses from hazardous chemicals and air, water and soil pollution and contamination



6. Ensure access to water and sanitation for all

- 6.3** By 2030 improve water quality by reducing pollution, eliminating dumping and minimising release of hazardous chemicals and materials, halving the proportion of untreated wastewater and substantially increasing recycling and safe reuse globally
- 6.6a** By 2030, expand international co-operation and capacity-building support to developing countries in water and sanitation related activities and programmes, including water harvesting, desalination, water efficiency, waste water treatment, recycling and reuse technologies
- 6.6b** Support and strengthen the participation of local communities in improving water and sanitation management



12. Ensure sustainable consumption & production practice

- 12.2** By 2030, achieve the sustainable management and efficient use of natural resources



13. Climate Action

- 13.1** Strengthen resilience and adaptive capacity to climate-related hazards and natural disasters in all countries
